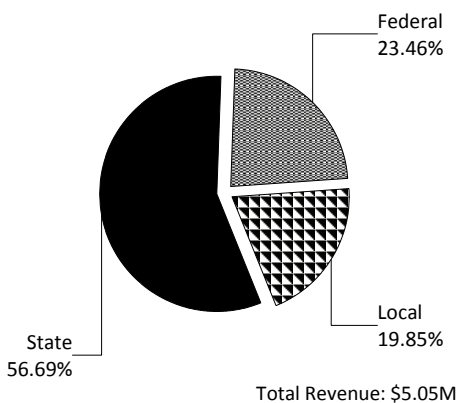

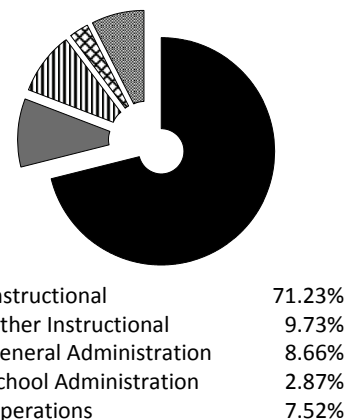
Revenue Sources
